Legacy Builders Curriculum (LBC) Overview

LBC:

- > is a four-week curriculum course for married couples
- equips couples to be leaders in their homes by showing their children examples of
 - healthy communication
 - > conflict resolution
 - problem solving skills
- cultivates partnership in marriage
- provides opportunities for couples to work toward shared goals.

LCB Purpose

The purpose of the Legacy Builders Curriculum is to:

- > teach learners skills to communicate effectively, resolve conflict, and problem solve in partnership
- equip learners to establish healthy standards and goals for *their* unique marriages and families.

Note: Relationship values and partnership principles are communicated throughout the LBC course. While couples are encouraged to focus responses toward those values and principles, LCB facilitators do not assess the appropriateness of couples' resolutions unless they are unlawful or otherwise potentially harmful to themselves or others.


- •combines three separate sections which articulate and build on one another from one level to the next


REAP Section—Learners will:
